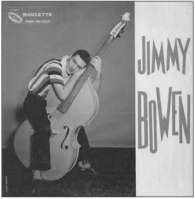

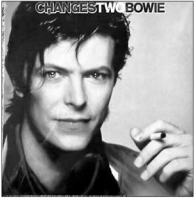

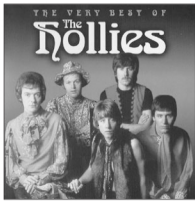

**HOLLY, Buddy [THE CRICKETS]**

Born Charles Hardin Holley on 9/7/1936 in Lubbock, Texas. One of rock and roll's most popular, legendary and innovative performers. Began recording western and pop demos with Bob Montgomery in 1954. Signed to Decca label in January 1956 and recorded in Nashville as Buddy Holly & The Three Tunes (Sonny Curtis, lead guitar; Don Guess, bass; and Jerry Ivan Allison, drums). In February 1957, Holly assembled his backing group, **The Crickets** (Allison; Niki Sullivan, rhythm guitar; and Joe B. Mauldin, bass), for recordings at Norman Petty's studio in Clovis, New Mexico. Signed to Brunswick and Coral labels (subsidiaries of Decca Records). Because of contract arrangements, all Brunswick records were released as The Crickets, and all Coral records were released as Buddy Holly. Holly split from The Crickets in the fall of 1958. Holly (age 22), **Ritchie Valens** and the **Big Bopper** were killed in a plane crash near Mason City, Iowa, on 2/3/1959. Gary Busey starred in the 1978 biographical movie *The Buddy Holly Story*. Mauldin died on 2/7/2015 (age 74). Also see **Ivan**.

Surf-pop-rock male vocal duo from Los Angeles, California. Jan Berry (born on 4/3/1941) and Dean Torrence (born on 3/10/1940) formed group called the Barons while attending high school. Dean left for a six-month Army Reserve stint, while Jan and Barons' member Arnie Ginsburg recorded as **Jan & Arnie** (see above). Upon Dean's return from the service, Arnie (not to be confused with the famed DJ of the same name) joined the Navy, and Jan & Dean signed with the Dore label. Dean sang lead on **The Beach Boys**'s 1966 hit "Barbara Ann." Jan was critically injured in an auto accident on 4/12/1966. Duo made a comeback in 1978 after their biographical movie *Dead Man's Curve* aired on TV. Jan died of a seizure on 3/26/2004 (age 62).

**PRESLEY, Elvis ♣** "The King of Rock and Roll." Born Elvis Aron Presley on 1/8/1935 in Tupelo, Mississippi. Died of heart failure caused by prescription drug abuse at his Graceland mansion in Memphis on 8/16/1977 (age 42). Moved to Memphis in 1948. First recorded for Sun in 1954. Signed to RCA Records on 11/22/1955. With his good looks, a passionate bluesy voice, a great band (**Bill Black**, bass; Scotty Moore, guitar; D.J. Fontana, drums), a smooth vocal quartet (The Jordanaires), and managed by Tom Parker (died on 1/21/1997), Presley blazed his way to the #1 star of rock and roll—a position he has never relinquished. Made his nationwide TV debut on **Tommy and Jimmy Dorsey's Stage Show** on 1/28/1956. Starred in 31 feature movies (beginning with *Love Me Tender* in 1956). In U.S. Army from 3/24/1958 to 3/5/1960. Married Priscilla Beaulieu on 5/1/1967; divorced on 10/11/1973. Their only child, Lisa Marie Presley (born on 2/1/1968), married **Michael Jackson** on 5/26/1994; divorced in 1996. Elvis's last live performance was in Indianapolis on 6/26/1977. The first rock and roll artist to be honored by the U.S. Postal Service with his own commemorative stamp on 1/8/1993. Elvis charted 85 Country hits, 1955-98 (including four songs on the Sun label); 53 Adult Contemporary hits, 1961-2002; and 35 R&B hits, 1956-63. The #1 Hot 100 artist of 1956, 1957, 1958, 1960, 1961 and 1962! Also see **The Pre-Rock Era**.
